RESOLUTION

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING BOARD

A resolution by the Carbon County Planning Board recommending approval of an update to the 2015 Carbon County Growth Policy to the Carbon County Board of Commissioners in accordance with MCA 76-1-603.

WHEREAS: The Carbon County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's first Comprehensive Plan in 1978 which operated as the community's guiding document for over 20 years, AND;

WHEREAS: When Montana's state planning statute was updated in 1999, the County followed suit by adopting a Growth Policy in 2003, and followed with updates in 2009 and 2015, AND;

WHEREAS: The Carbon County Planning Board and Board of Commissioners is desirous of establishing and maintaining up to date growth management regulations including, but not limited to, Growth Policy, Subdivision, Development, and Floodplain Regulations, intended to protect the public's health, safety and welfare, AND;

WHERAS: The Carbon County Board of Commissioners is statutorily required to update and examine the Growth Policy on a time frame not to exceed 5 calendar years, AND;

WHEREAS: Following extensive public outreach and stake holder involvement as part of the Growth Policy update, the Carbon County Planning Board held a public hearing on November 19, 2019, AND;

WHEREAS: After consideration of the recommendations and suggestions elicited at the public hearing, MCA 76-1-603 requires the Carbon County Planning Board to forward a recommendation to the Carbon County Commission on the adoption of the updated Growth Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Carbon County Planning Board hereby recommends that the 2020 update to the Carbon County Growth Policy be adopted by the Carbon County Board of Commissioners as drafted.
