

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

June 18, 2024

Commissioners Scott Miller, Scott Blain, and Bill Bullock, and Administrative Officer Angela Newell were present.

8:30 Pledge of Allegiance.

Brad Caton and Tracy Timmons from the Red Lodge Area Community Foundation met for an update. Timmons noted funding has been secured to support for the Carbon County Area Ride & Transit (CART) system for another year. Caton noted a 13-passenger van, that was ordered pre-COVID was delivered although the price increased by over \$50,000. RLACF is looking at being able to offer a shuttle service and what limitations there are within State Grant funding restrictions. Timmons also discussed challenges with parking and noted they are looking at the future rotation of the fleet.

All three Commissioners participated in the Edgar Sewer & Lighting Board meeting last Thursday. Commissioners discussed the District potentially petitioning to be a Sewer District rather than an RSID.

Bullock noted his attendance at the Fair Board meeting yesterday. Noted public comment was received about lights; the Board discussed their concerns about vandalism and vagrants that warrant lighting. Blain noted there has been good feedback on the Fair's facilities following the Jackpot event this weekend.

9:00 Clerk and Recorder Macque Bohleen met with Commissioners regarding the Primary Election Canvas. Bohleen noted the Post-Election Audit was Thursday and was within Statutory margins (within +/- 5 votes) for the reconciliation. Bohleen plans to have a debrief regarding the Primary Election to continue to improve and learn from past election experiences. Bullock moved to accept the Election Canvas for the June 4, 2024 Primary Election; Blain seconded; motion carried.

Bohleen and Commissioners discussed the Ambulance Levy which was passed county-wide with good support.

9:10 Recessed until next agenda item.

9:30 Weed District Coordinator Brian Ostwald met for his Preliminary Budget Meeting. Ostwald discussed water issues in the weed shop conference room, needed repairs, and the possibility of new construction for office functions. With the current building costs, Commissioners believe it is more feasible to repair the structure. Commissioners discussed scheduling more regular meetings with Ostwald regarding his department, a meeting will be scheduled for autumn following the summer spray season.

Commissioners also discussed, weed control at County gravel pits, roads, and other County Property. Ostwald and Commissioners also discussed the weed bonding process and administrative challenges with ownership turnover; Ostwald believes it be better to go through the non-compliance process with current owners.

10:00 Human Resource Specialist Kate Asbury met for a monthly update (attached).

10:16 Meeting Recessed.

10:30 Sanitarian Barbara Krizek met for the Environmental Health Preliminary Budget. Thanked Commissioners for the Cost of Living Increase and would like additional increases for Lori Kane and Jesse Gutierrez who are exceeding her expectations. Krizek also noted the Temporary Clerk has been extremely helpful in working through filing backlog and requested to create a Permanent Part-Time Clerk at 16 hrs/week (presented hiring authorization). Discussed the Permanent Clerk's Role in Code Enforcement data input. Blain moved to approve the Hiring Authorization for Environmental Health; Bullock seconded; motion carried. Krizek discussed inspection software being implemented by the State for licensed establishment inspections and requested a budget increase for inspection tablets.

Commissioners would like to evaluate merit-based raises when going through balancing budget process.

10:54 Meeting recessed.

11:00 Geospatial Information Systems Coordinator / Fire Warden Tom Kohley met for his preliminary budget meeting. Kohley discussed the Community Wildfire Protection Program (CWPP) Grant and Plan. Actionable Items would include the identification of projects that would reduce wildfire exposure and could include fuel mitigation or workshops for homeowners. Kohley noted the CWPP Plan will also impact what areas are in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI). Discussion of CWPP giving the County the opportunity to develop a protection priority asset list and a resource list. Kohley discussed the upcoming Subdivision Regulations update and his hope that with that update regulations can be implemented to mitigate fire concerns when subdivisions are approved. Kohley and Commissioners discussed the future separation of Fire Warden and GIS Functions into two separate positions; seasonal workload changes; and different configurations for Fire Warden roles and responsibilities in other Counties. Kohley's goal is to have little to no budget impact in creating a $\frac{3}{4}$ time Fire Warden Position with current grant funding.

Kohley noted the possibility for GIS efficiencies for other departments if it were a full-time position. Commissioners discussed the Full-Time Equivalent employee needs for the Fire Warden position.

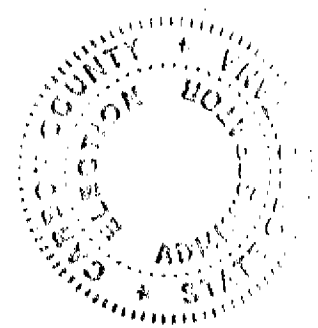
