COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

February 20, 2025

Commissioners Scott Miller, Scott Blain, and Bill Bullock, Deputy Clerk Katrina Kruger and Administrative Officer Angela Newell were present.

8:30 Pledge of Allegiance.

8:35 Public Comment. DES Coordinator Cyrina Allen was in attendance. Blain reviewed the extreme weather conditions from February 19, 2025, reporting a Sheriff's Patrol car had been hit while stopped at an accident site. Allen added monitoring of conditions are ongoing. Bullock mentioned he had received a telephone call from Montana Independent News asking why emergency notifications had not been released on CodeRed. Allen advised the Montana Department of Transportation was responsible for the notifications that went out. Seeing no further public comment, Presiding Officer Blain recessed the meeting until the next agenda item.

9:00 Bullock noted severe weather conditions on February 19, 2025 had prompted passage of Resolution 2025-08 Emergency Declaration. As the Weather Emergency had passed, Bullock moved to rescind the Emergency Declaration; Miller seconded. Blain noted the conditions may again warrant an Emergency Declaration within the week. Motion carried.

Boyd Ranch Subdivision Final Plat. Kate Stout with Red Lodge Surveying and Clerk and Recorder Macque Bohleen joined the meeting. Contract County Planner Forrest Mandeville joined on-line and reviewed the conditions of the Preliminary Plat. Having reviewed and considered the application materials, project memorandum, and all the information presented, Miller moved to approve the Boyd Ranch Subdivision, final plat. Bullock seconded. Bohleen noted minor inconsistencies in the legal description on the Subdivision Guarantee. Bohleen and Stout discussed having the Subdivision Guarantee corrected. Motion carried. Presiding Officer Blain recessed the meeting until the next agenda item.

9:30 City of Red Lodge Mayor Westwood was unavailable for the meeting.

10:00 County Attorney Alex Nixon was unavailable for the meeting.

10:30 Consent Agenda. Bullock moved to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of Employee Time Status Review; ARPA Grant Recipient Lobbying Certification and Conflict of Interest form; DNRC-CARDD Grant Reimbursement Request in the amount of \$3,467.44; Miller seconded. Motion carried.


