SUBJECT: Information Required for Issuance of On-site Wastewater Treatment System Approval -Title 50 (20 acres or greater, unplatted, platted prior to Sanitation in Subdivision Act)

The following data, but not limited to, is required for the review of on-site wastewater treatment systems for obtaining an authorization to install a septic system in Carbon County:

- □ Complete legal description include copy of plat or COS.
- □ Soils Test Pit (8 ft. depth minimum) applicant to provide the following:
  - Provide 72 hours email notice to Department in advance of Soil Test Pit excavation
  - Depth to seasonal groundwater (Acquire pre-determination from Department regarding need for Ground Water Monitoring during run-off/irrigation seasons prior to Soil Test Pit excavation)
  - Depth to bedrock (if applicable)
  - Soil types (in accordance with DEQ 4 Appendix B to include percentage of rock)
  - NRCS soil data provided
- Percolation test per DEQ 4 Table 2.1-1 and in accordance with DEQ-4 Appendix A
- Demonstrate compliance with non-degradation requirements (75-5-301 MCA) applicant must submit the following data:
  - A copy of USGS topo map including location of property, locations of well logs for calculating hydraulic conductivity, and location of the well where nitrate sample was obtained.
  - Water Sample (Nitrate Background Analysis report)
  - Nitrate sensitivity analysis (include hydraulic conductivity and hydraulic gradient calculations)
  - Phosphorus break-out determination
- Lot Layout Plan: Paper sizes accepted: 8½ X 11 11 X 17 applicant to provide the following details:
  - Legal Description
  - Scale, Legend, North Arrow
  - Water source (type and location ie. Well, Cistern)
  - o Drainfield Location (Primary Drainfield and 100% Replacement Drainfield Area)
  - Slope given for drainfield area
  - o Dwelling location labeled with number of bedrooms
  - Mixing Zone
  - o Soil test pit and percolation test (if necessary) location
  - Location of any streams, ditches, and any neighboring wells
  - Wells, drainfields, and/or mixing zones within 100ft perimeter outside of boundaries shown (and statement that all are shown).
  - o 100-year floodplain requirements met, and floodplain and drainages shown
- Drainfield plans and specifications designed in accordance with DEQ 4
- □ Review Fee Calculation Checklist and appropriate fees with check payable to Carbon County.
