GENERAL FUND MILL LEVY

Shall the board of trustees be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of eighty two thousand two hundred twenty and thirty one cents DOLLARS (\$82,220.31) per year which is approximately 15.77 mills, for the purpose of: maintaining and operating Fromberg School District’s General Fund .

Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$21.29 , on a home with a market value of \$300,000 by approximately \$63.87, and on a home with a market value of \$600,000 by approximately by \$127.74. An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs. The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the district levies that amount each year thereafter.

However, lowering over-BASE tax levies in any year will lower the amount of permissively over-BASE levies in subsequent years.
